

Good Attendance



Transition Days – July 16-17

- Transition days for all students will take place on Tuesday, 16 July and Wednesday, 17 July.
- Aims: to support our 2024 Year 7 cohort to become familiar with the building, key staff and expectations around how life works here at Barnsley Academy.
- Students should arrive by 8.15am and will finish at 2.50pm.



- School finishes at 2:50pm




Your support

- Remember, we know how important your child is.




